## Happy 145th Anniversary Bradford National Bank!

### History

Bradford National Bank was founded in 1867 by James Bradford and his son. They operated on the east side of the Greenville square. Under the direction of Herman Riedemann, the bank received its national charter in 1910. In 1967, as the bank celebrated its 100th anniversary, a new

facility was constructed at 100 East College. Today, the bank has locations in Greenville, Highland and Marine. Later this year, the bank will celebrate its 10th anniversary serving the Highland Community.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### How do I reset my Internet Banking password online?

Log into your Internet Banking. Click on the "Other" tab. Select, "Personal Information." Make sure your current email is correct. At the bottom of the page, check the box that gives you the ability to reset your password electronically. Click on the "Update" button.

If you do not do this and you are locked out of your internet banking, you will have to call the bank at 618-664-2200, or 651-1700 during normal banking hours to reset your password.

### If I want to increase my debit card limit, who do I contact?

Call 664-2200 during normal banking hours and ask for the IT Department (computer room). Depending on your situation, you may be required to fill out a request form and sign-off on the request. In most cases, the limit increase is temporary.
