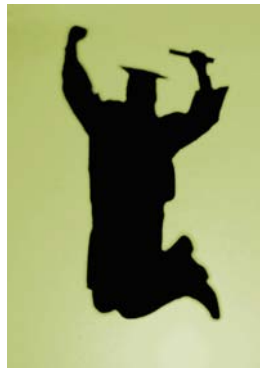

Drs. Jennifer Ostrom and Lynette Hemker purchased the clinic in January of 2012.

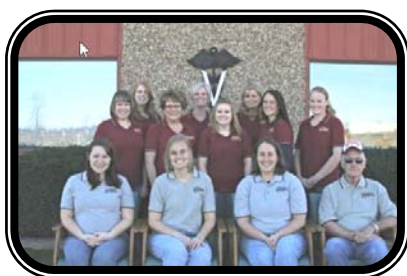
