## Cardinals/Cubs

We have obtained 25 tickets to the Cardinals/Cubs day game on Wednesday, **May 25**. Because the tickets have to be paid entirely upon reservation, we had to limit how many we bought to be reasonably sure we could sell them. When they are gone, it may not be possible to get more. These sell out quickly.



Busch Stadium still allows customers to bring in food and beverages as long as they aren't in glass or cans. All bags are subject to inspection. You can bring your lunch or buy ballpark food. A meal is not included on this day trip. Game time is 12:45 p.m. and we will arrive earlier.

Cost is **\$59** per person. Register by April 25.



## Presidential Aircraft and More

Join the Bradford Travel Club for an exciting short trip to Dayton, Ohio, the Birthplace of Aviation, from **June 21-23**. This city was the home of the Wright Brothers.

The world's largest and oldest military aviation museum features more than 360 aerospace vehicles, missiles and artifacts. We will be among the first to tour the newly renovated Building 4 which houses the retired presidential planes. Also, walk through a Nasa shuttle, sit in a cockpit, and see the B-2 stealth bomber.

We will visit the Carillon His-



torical Park and Brewing Company (a fully operational 1850s brewery and restaurant) and see the 1905 Wright Flyer III, one of two existing planes built and flown by the Wright Brothers. Some of Dayton's oldest buildings are located here. The park is also home to Deeds Carillon.

At the Schuster Center we will have a pre-show buffet dinner and see the Lion King from the traveling Broadway series.

Before heading home on the third morning, we will visit the Sun Watch Village and Archaeological Park. This is Dayton's oldest

neighborhood. This reconstructed Fort Ancient Indian Village is a National Historic Landmark. We will have a group lunch at the Amber Rose before departing.



Cost is **\$695** per person double occupancy, **\$795** single. Includes transportation, lodging, baggage handling, all site admissions, all gratuities, 2 continental breakfasts, 2 lunches, and one dinner, tour of Dayton with a step-on guide and escort. Payment due by May 1.



## Rural Fruits and Labors—Calhoun County



Spend a day in the country learning about some of the Rural Fruits and Labors in scenic Calhoun County on **July 13**. Our guide will be life-long resident Rhonda Thomas.

The tour will take us to a horse training facility which offers boarding and equine services. We will get a demonstration of them train-

ing the horses using the Parelli method.

Corn and beans are two major crops in Calhoun County. We will stop at the Jersey County Grain Elevators in Hardin to see the "pit area" where grains are prepared to be loaded onto barges for transport.

Get ready for peach season with

a visit to a family owned and operated orchard. This behind the scenes tour will show us how peaches go from the planting process to harvest.

Lunch will be at a mom and pop type restaurant with a view of the Illinois River. Mark food choice on the registration form. **\$79** per person. Register by June 13.

## Magic Chef and World's Fair

Next we will have lunch at Bixby's in the Missouri History Museum. We will choose between a BLT and chicken salad sandwich that day.

We will visit their special exhibit

see film footage, listen to popular music of the day, compare 1904 prices to those today, and much more. If time allows, we'll visit the other exhibits and gift shop.

A driving tour of Forest Park will show us sculptures, structures and buildings left by the Fair. We will disembark briefly at a site or two.

Washington University contains the site of the 1904 Olympics. Then we will tour University City's very unique City Hall where the world's largest search

## Chip Cards Coming to BNB

In the coming months, Bradford National Bank will begin the reissuance of credit cards for both Mastercard and Visa. The new credit cards will be EMV compliant, which means they will have a chip embedded in the card (EMV stands for Europay, Mastercard, Visa).

New EMV compliant chip cards will be issued to BNB credit card holders when their existing card is set to expire.


With the addition of the chip, it may change the way you make purchases at local businesses.

- If the merchant machine can handle the chip card, your card must remain in the machine for the duration of your transaction (see above instructions).
- If the merchant machine does not handle the chip card, you may continue to make transactions with the traditional swipe.

Chip technology is used world-wide and is slowly being adopted in the United States. Chips contain encrypted information that makes it extremely difficult for the card to be copied or counterfeited. At merchants that use chip terminals, the card and terminal work together to add an additional layer of security to the transaction.

EMV chip technology will also soon be available with the Bradford National Bank debit card.

### How to Use Your EMV Chip Debit Card



1. Insert your chip card into a chip-friendly reader.

2. Approve the amount.

3. Follow prompt to enter your PIN or to sign.

4. Remove your chip card when prompted.
